



ADDITIONAL APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

To complete your C.W. Driver Foundation scholarship application, please submit the following by **May 14, 2021**.

- ✓ Personal Essay: This is a very important part of your application. Please provide a personal essay on a separate piece of paper and enclose this with your application.

On a separate document tells us about yourself and why you plan to attend vocational school or college. You may include any of the following: significant events and/or persons who have influenced your life; personal interests; academic and career goals; your reason for your chosen academic major, if you have decided upon one; and any other comment(s) that you wish to share. Please also discuss how you have helped other people or plan on helping other people in the future. Remember, we read your essay to find out more about you – so please take your time and compose a clear essay. Your essay should be no longer than 3 pages and typed double-spaced or neatly handwritten.

- ✓ Academic Transcript(s): Arrange to have your academic transcript(s) sent to the address below prior to the **May 14, 2021 deadline**. If you are currently enrolled in high school, the academic transcript(s) must include all of the 10th, 11th, and first-term 12th year grades, and college grades, if applicable. Students should also submit transcripts for classes taken at any college if these grades are not posted on the high school transcript or have been taken since high school. If you have not taken any of these tests or if you are currently enrolled in college, tests scores are not required.
- ✓ Confidential Recommendation Forms: Ask that an instructor, guidance counselor, employer, supervisor, coach, or volunteer supervisor to submit a recommendation using the C.W. Driver Foundation Scholarship Fund Confidential Recommendation Form. For example, have you participated in community service, childcare, an organized activity, or sport, or assisted at your place of worship? Alternatively, you may request one of these persons who knows you well (other than a family member or friend) to write a letter of recommendation on your behalf. You may also ask a supervisor in one of these alternate activities or an employer to write this recommendation. Either attach the letters to your application or arrange for the letter to be sent prior to the **May 14, 2021 deadline**.
